But while some of these things may be ok. They are not all bad. They don't actually fix the main problem. That is that all of us have turned away from a good God and decided we would run our own lives.

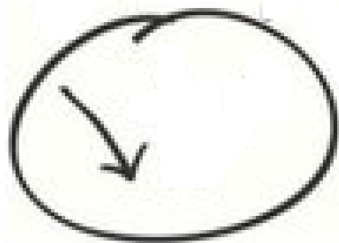


We did the things God had said not to do and we didn't do the things God said to do. This is what the bible calls sin.
